# Hi-Way Robbery

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition. Course Designer: David Jenkins

### STAGE PROCEDURE

**Start Position:** Standing in the shooting area, wrist below belt, heels touching rear fault-line

**Gun Ready Condition:** Loaded and holstered  
On signal engage targets as available.

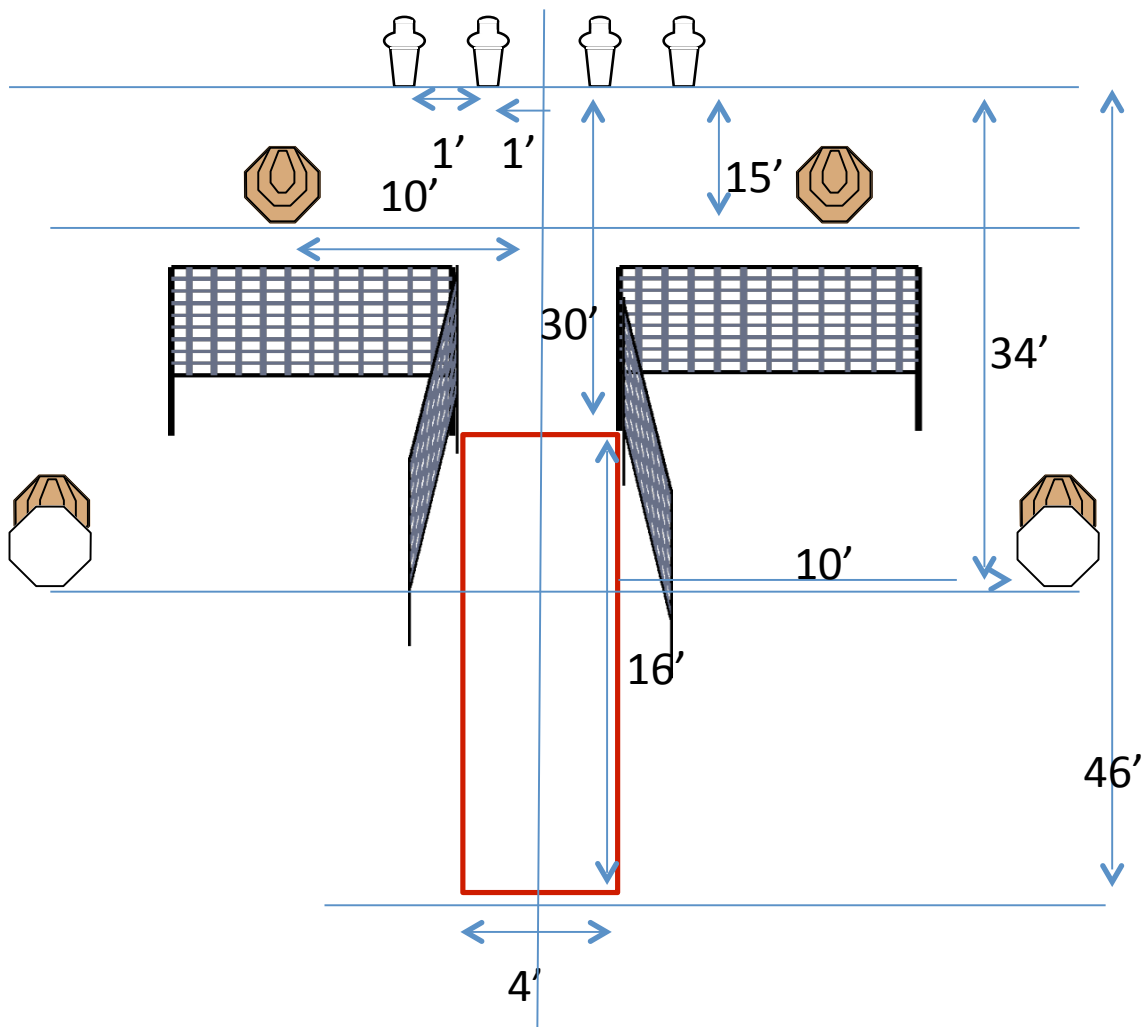
**Scoring:** Comstock ,12 Rounds

**Targets:** 4 IPSC, 4 USPSA Mini PP

**Scored Hits:** Best 2 Steel 1 A

**Start - Stop:** Audible - Last Shot

**Penalties:** Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules.



**SETUP NOTES:** Targets are 5' to top of target, NS are "point to point" at the A zone letter. Targets are spaced edge to edge. Up-range walls placed right against faultline.

# Hi-Way Robbery

Hi-Way Robbery is a 12 round, 60-point, Comstock Short Course. There are 4 IPSC targets and 4 USPSA mini poppers. The best 2 hits per cardboard will score and steel must fall to score.

The handgun start position is standing inside shooting area, facing downrange, heels touching rear fault line, wrists below belt with handgun loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is standing inside shooting area, facing downrange, heels touching rear fault line, holding loaded PCC with safety on, stock on belt, and muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage targets as they become available from within the shooting area.
